



What to expect when working with us.

1. Once you've chosen us as your contractor we'll schedule the Contract Signing and Preconstruction meetings (these two may occur in the same meeting). We will provide you with a certificate of insurance along with license details.
2. We will establish a group text for the duration of the project that we can use to exchange ideas. Every Friday we will update you on the project's progress. To help facilitate our exchange of ideas we encourage sharing Pinterest boards or Houzz ideabooks.
3. You will receive a Google Project Schedule that will be updated in real time throughout the project. If there are change orders (whether an increase or decrease in value or project duration) the Project Schedule will reflect any changes.
4. The building permit will be posted a few days prior to starting. If okay by the Homeowners' Association, we will have a dump trailer outside along with a portable toilet (as applicable).

5. We will prep the areas we'll be working in prior to any demolition, but we encourage you to do what you need to ensure your belongings are in a safe and secure area.
 6. Throughout the project there will be inspections that we will notify you about when passed.
 7. Selections: This is a 2-week +/- process and usually happens during the Design Phase with us; however, if you've worked up a design prior to engaging us as your contractor and still need to choose your selections then we will work with you in selecting these. This includes an appliance package, sample cabinets (and vanities), electrical and plumbing fixtures package.
 8. At the completion of the project you will receive a Project Completion Packet that will have pertinent project information.
 9. When all is 100% complete we may request to take professional project photos.



10. At project completion you will receive a 1-year warranty on any labor and materials supplied by our company. (Owner-supplied selections are not included in our warranty; however, installations of owner-supplied selections are included under our 1-year warranty if it is discovered that the problem(s) arose due to faulty installation.)
